



Draught of twenty acres and seven perches of land with 6 p cent
for roads situate in Formanagh township in Mifflin county surveyed
6th July 1812 in pursuance of a warrant to James Watt dated 14th
April 1812. Note, improvement on premises, at the time the survey
was made a cabin-house, I think 18 feet long and 16 feet in breadth
covered with bards in which were living the warrantees his wife and
their 5 or 6 children; about an acre and an half of land cleared
under good fence, in which was growing a crop of corn.
