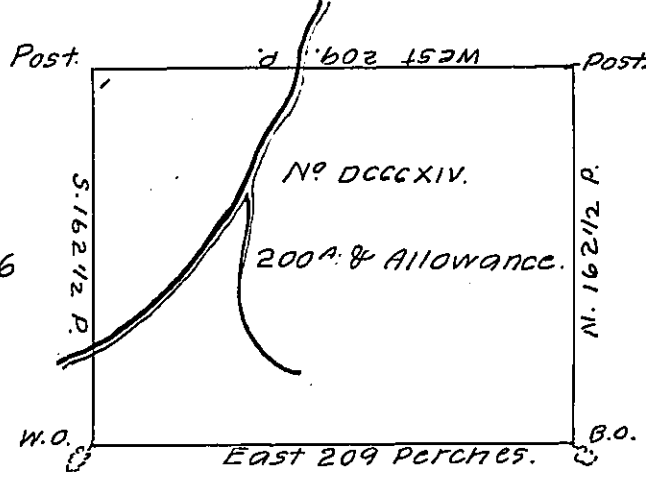

In Pursuance of an Act of General Assembly of the State of Pen<sup>a</sup>. Passed the 24<sup>th</sup> day of Feb<sup>r</sup> 1785 entitled "an Act for directing the Mode of distributing the Donation Lands promised the Troops of this Commonwealth," and by order of the Surveyor General, with the Approbation of the Hon<sup>e</sup>, the Executive Council, I have Survey'd on the 8<sup>th</sup> day of September 1785, the above described Tract of two hundred Acres of Land & Allowance of six  $\frac{1}{2}$  Ct. for roads &c. No DCCCXIV situate in District No. 4. on the west side of the Allegany river in the County of Westmoreland.
