In Pursuance of an Act of Assembly of the State of Pennsylvania passed the 24th day of February 1785 entitled an Act for directing the Mode of distributing the Donation Lands promised the Troops of this Common Wealth and by Order of the Surveyor General with the approbation of the Hon^{ble} the Executive Council; I have surveyed on the 27th day of September, the above discribed Tract of Five Hundred Acres of Land & Allowance of Six & Cent for roads &c No^o LXXXI Situate in District No^o 5 on the west side of the Alleghany river in the County of Westmoreland.
