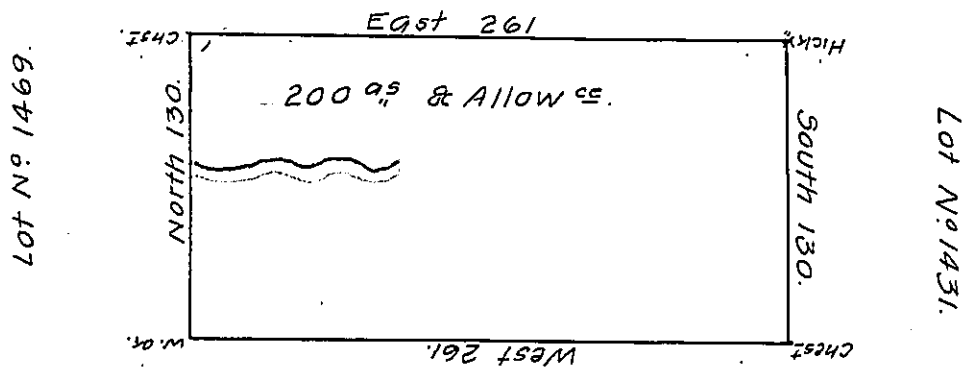

In pursuance of an act of General Assembly of the state of Pennsylvania passed the 24th day of February 1785 Intituled an act for Distributing the Donation Lands Promised to the troops of this Commonwealth & by order of the surveyor Gen<sup>l</sup> with the Aprobaton of the Hon<sup>le</sup> the Executive Council I have surveyed on the 18<sup>th</sup> day of Augt 1785 the above Described tract of two Hund<sup>d</sup> Acres & Allow<sup>cs</sup> of 6<sup>th</sup> Cent. for roads &c N<sup>o</sup> MCCCCXL situate In Dist<sup>ct</sup> N<sup>o</sup> 7 on the West side of the Alleg<sup>y</sup> River In the County of Wesmorland.
