

In pursuance of an act of General Assembly of the state of Pennsylvania passed the 24<sup>th</sup> day of February 1785 Intitled an act for Directing the mode of Distributing the Donation Lands Promised to the troops of this Commonwealth & by order of the Surveyor General with the Approbation of the Hon<sup>e</sup>s the Executive Council I have surveyed on the 17<sup>th</sup> day of Augt 1785 the above Described tract of two Hundred Acres & allow<sup>r</sup> of 6<sup>t</sup> Cent. for Roads &c N° Mccccxxxii situate in Dist N° 7 on the west side of the Allegheny River in the county of Westmoreland.
