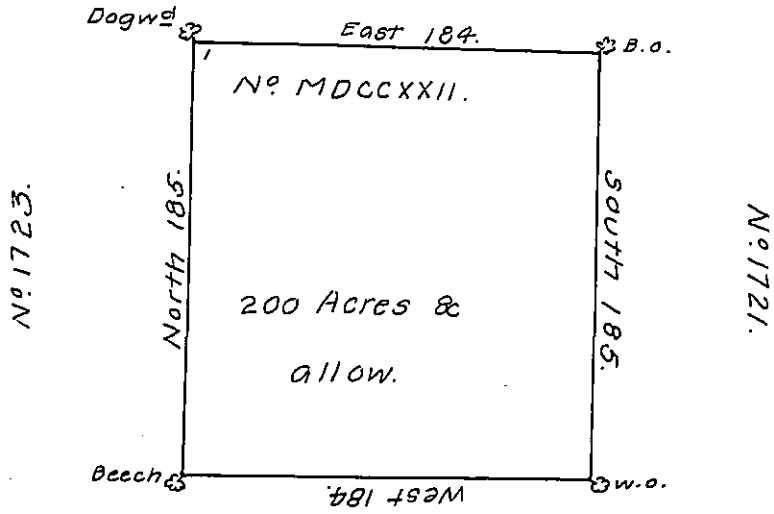

Rogers dated the tenth day of March 1795.

In pursuance of an Act of General Assembly of the state of Pennsylvania  
passed the 24<sup>th</sup> day of February, 1785, entitled "An Act for directing the  
mode of distributing the Donation Lands promised the Troops of this Com-  
monwealth"; and by order of the Surveyor General with the approbation  
of the Honourable the Supreme Executive Council, I have surveyed on the  
14<sup>th</sup> day of November 1785, the above described Tract of two hundred  
acres of land, and allowance of six per cent for roads, &c

N<sup>o</sup> 1722 situate in District No. 8. on the west side of the Allegany river,  
in the county of Westmoreland.
