



Situated on a Branch of the Shawanese Gabbin Creek in St. Clair Township (formerly Cumberland) now Bedford County Containing Eighty Acres with the allowance of six $\frac{1}{2}$ Cent for Roads &c. Surveyed for Charles Pollock January 22^d 1800 (along old lines which appear to have been run about the year 1766) on Location dated September 15th 1767 N^o 1259.

N.B. A Survey made on Warrant in the Name of John Reiley & returned to the Surveyor Generals Office June 18th 1794. interferes with the above Survey. ~
