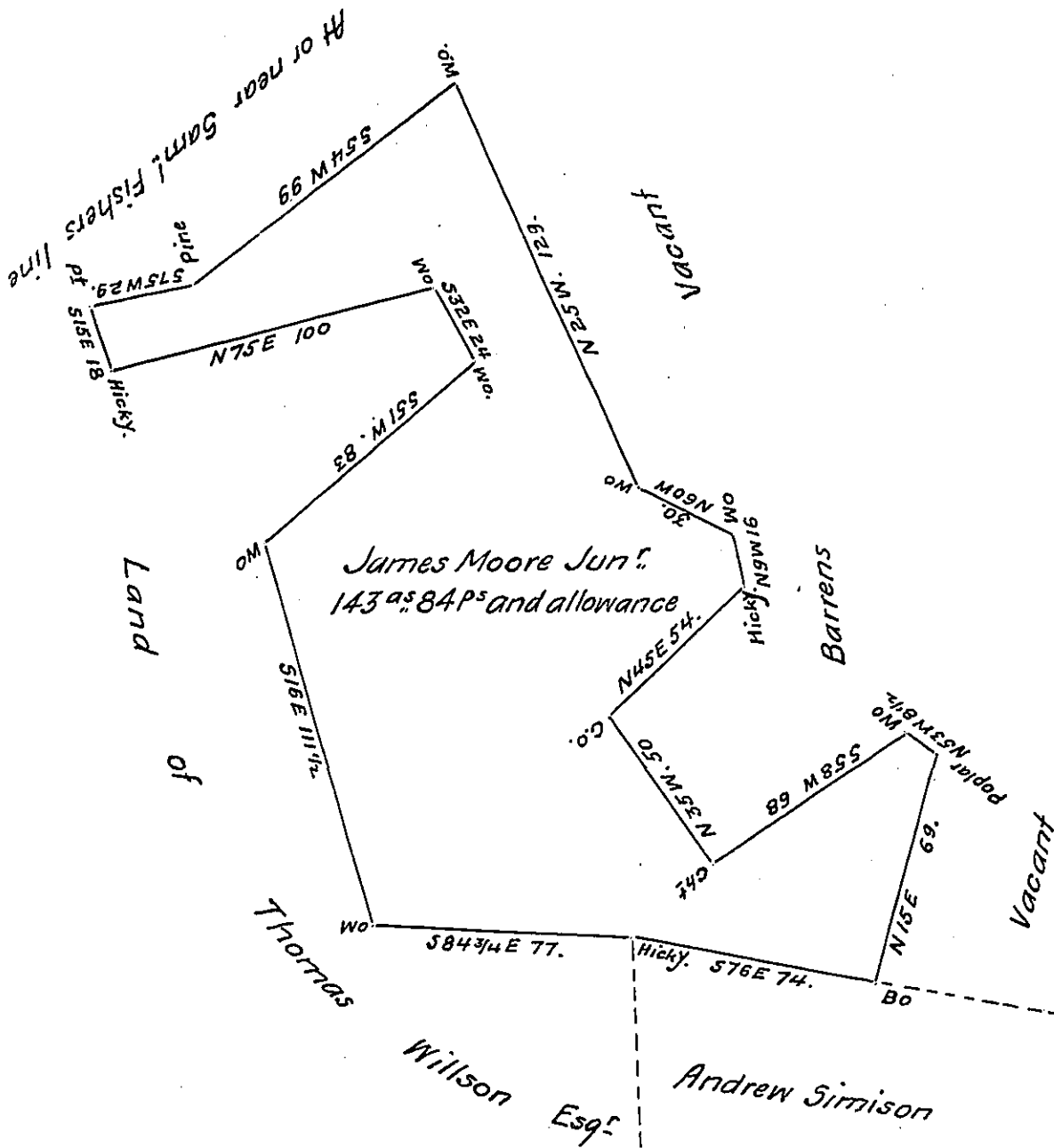

Containing 86<sup>as</sup> 145<sup>ps</sup> & allow<sup>ce</sup> as by the rough Office draft appears (which is erroneos) and by calculation on the old notes said tract contains One hundred forty three Acres and 84 perches and allowance January the 30<sup>th</sup> A.D. 1824.
