


William Gallaghers Land



February 5th 1840.

Surveyed the above described Tract of Land
in Pursuance of A Warrant Granted to Hamilton Beaty
Edward M. Smith Thomas Fungison and Joseph Coulter in
Trust for the Unity Presbyterian Congregation bearing date
the 17th day of December 1839. Containing Sixty Acres
and four perches and the Usual Allowance of Six per
Cent for Roads &c Situate in Unity Township And in the
County of Westmoreland.
