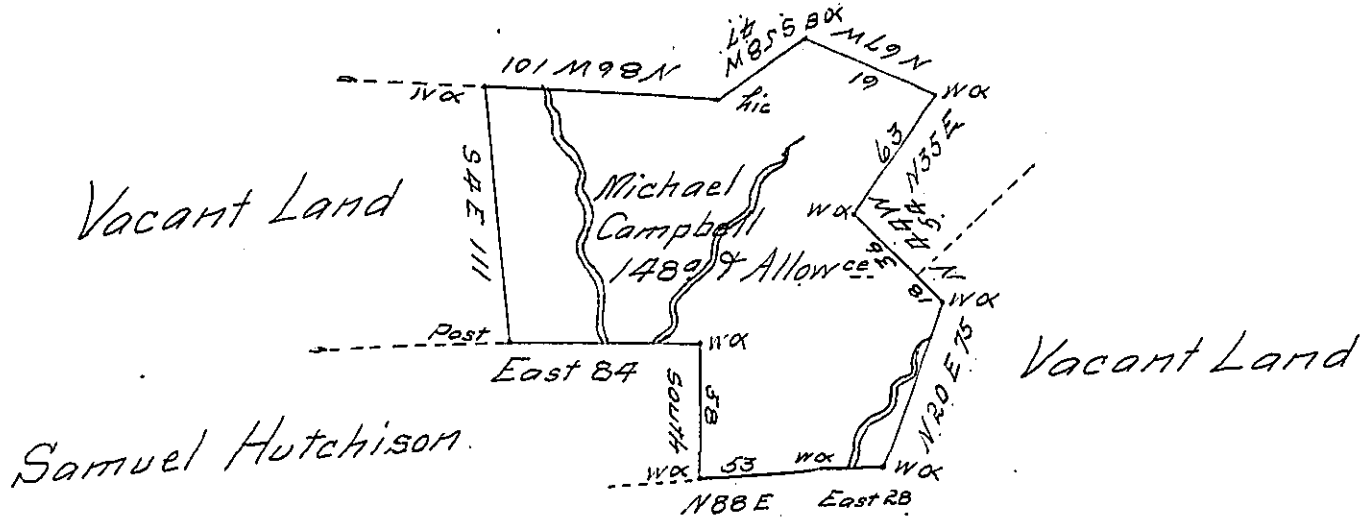


Jonathan Nesbitt

Situate on a run above Samuel Hutchison's & joining land of said Hutchison which run empties into Kiskaminates about one or two miles above Warrens Sleeping place in Armstrong Township Westmoreland County. By warrant of the 11th Augt. 1786.
