



The Shaded lines in the above Diagram represent a Survey made to Humphry Fullerton on the 5th of May 1775 By Wart of the 23^d of July 1773. The dotted lines represent two interfering Surveys made on new purchase Warrants one in the name of Clared Ingerson No. 257 the other in the name of Timothy Pickering No. 265 Situate in Mahoning Township Indiana County North of the purchase of 1768 and within the purchase of 1784 - in the occupancy of Scraggs Work who Claims under the title to Clared Ingerson ascertained in pursuance of the Several acts of assembly directing the money of the principal and interest due to the Commonwealth from persons holding lands by Virtue of Locations or other office titles issued from or under this proprietary government and by the authority of the Board of Property.
