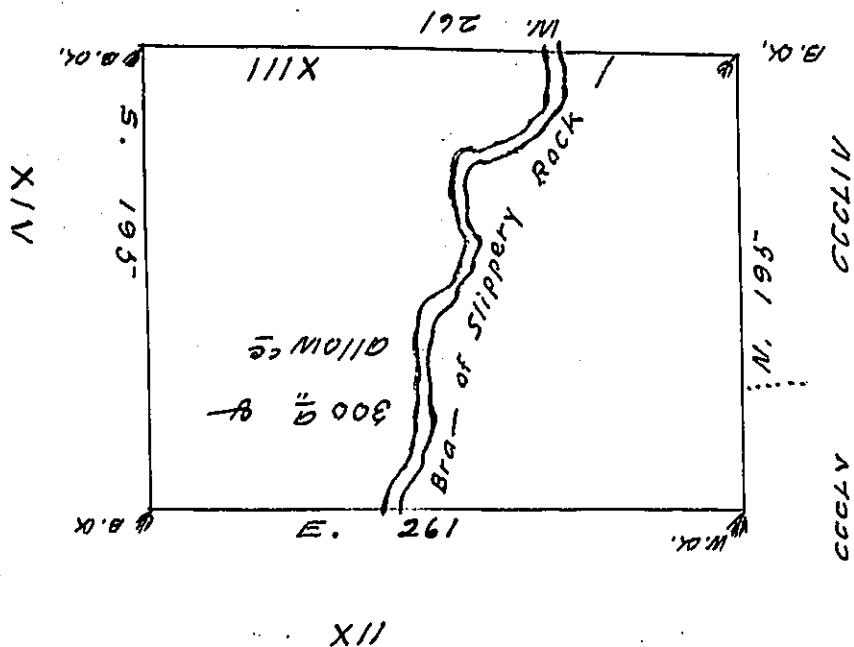


District No 3



In pursuance of an Act of General Assembly of the state of Pennsylvania passed the 24<sup>th</sup> day of February 1785 entitled an Act for directing the mode of distributing the donation lands promised the troops by the Commonwealth, and by order of the Surveyor General with the approbation of the honourable the Executive Council. I have surveyed on the 4<sup>th</sup> day of November 1785 the above described tract of three hundred acres of land & allomance of six  $\frac{1}{2}$  Cent for roads & No XIII situate in district No 2 on the west side of Allegany river in Westmar-land County
