

IN PURSUANCE OF AN ACT OF GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF THE STATE
OF PENNSYLVANIA PASSED THE 24TH DAY OF FEBRUARY 1785 EN-

TRACT OF TWO HUNDRED ACRES OF LAND & THE ALLOWANCE OF SIX
PER CENT FOR ROADS NO CCCLXVII SITUATE IN DISTRICT NO 2
ON THE WEST SIDE OF ALLEGANY RIVER IN WESTMORELAND COUNTY.
