By virtue of a warrant dated the 18th of April 1785 and order of survey rec'd February 25th 1846. Surveyed March 23d 1846 to Boudewine Howey the above described tract of land situate on both sides of Middle Bushkill Creek about one mile from the mouth (formerly Delaware) now Lehman Township (formerly Northampton) now Pike County, containing two hundred and ninety nine acres, seventy four perches and allowance of six pr Ct. for roads &c.
