



Draft of Survey, of Tract No. 31, of the Preserved lands, adjoining the Town of Erie, The whole tract contains one hundred twenty six acres & seventy perches, that part of said tract sold by James Brotherton to Judah Colt Esqr and by said Colt to John Kauffman late of Lancaster County deceased, contains one hundred sixteen acres and sixty nine perches, that part sold by James Brotherton to the Erie and Waterford Turnpike road Company, contains seven acres and two perches and the remainder of the tract containing two acres and one hundred and fifty nine perches is covered by the Turnpike road aforesaid. Surveyed April 1st, 1813.
