



In pursuance of a law passed the 11th day of April, 1799, for
 selling certain Reserved tracts of land therein named. The instruc-
 tions of the (Late) Governor dated the 14th day of May 1799 and
 the Order of the Surveyor Genl. dated the 18th day of May 1799,
 Surveyed the 20th day of September 1799 the above described
 tract of land being Lott No. 32 of the Reserved - called Erie (now)
 the County of Erie Containing one hundred & seventeen acres
 & sixty perches, Strict Measure.
