 selling certain Reserved tracts of land, therein named, the instructions  
 of the (Late) Governor dated the 14th day of May 1799, and the Order  
 Surveyed the 17 of September  
 of the Surveyor Genl dated the 18th day of May 1799, the above Reserved  
 tract called Erie, (now) Erie County, containing one hundred &  
 twenty six acres & seventy perches, Strict Measure.
