



In pursuance of a law passed the 11th day of April 1799, for selling certain Reserved Tracts of land therein named, the Instructions of the Late Governor dated the 14th day of May, 1799 & the Order of the Surveyor General, dated the 18th day of May, 1799, Surveyed the 3d day of October 1799, the above described Tract of Land, being No. 42 of the Reserved tract called Erie (now) Erie County, Containing eighty eight acres and thirty two perches, strict measure
