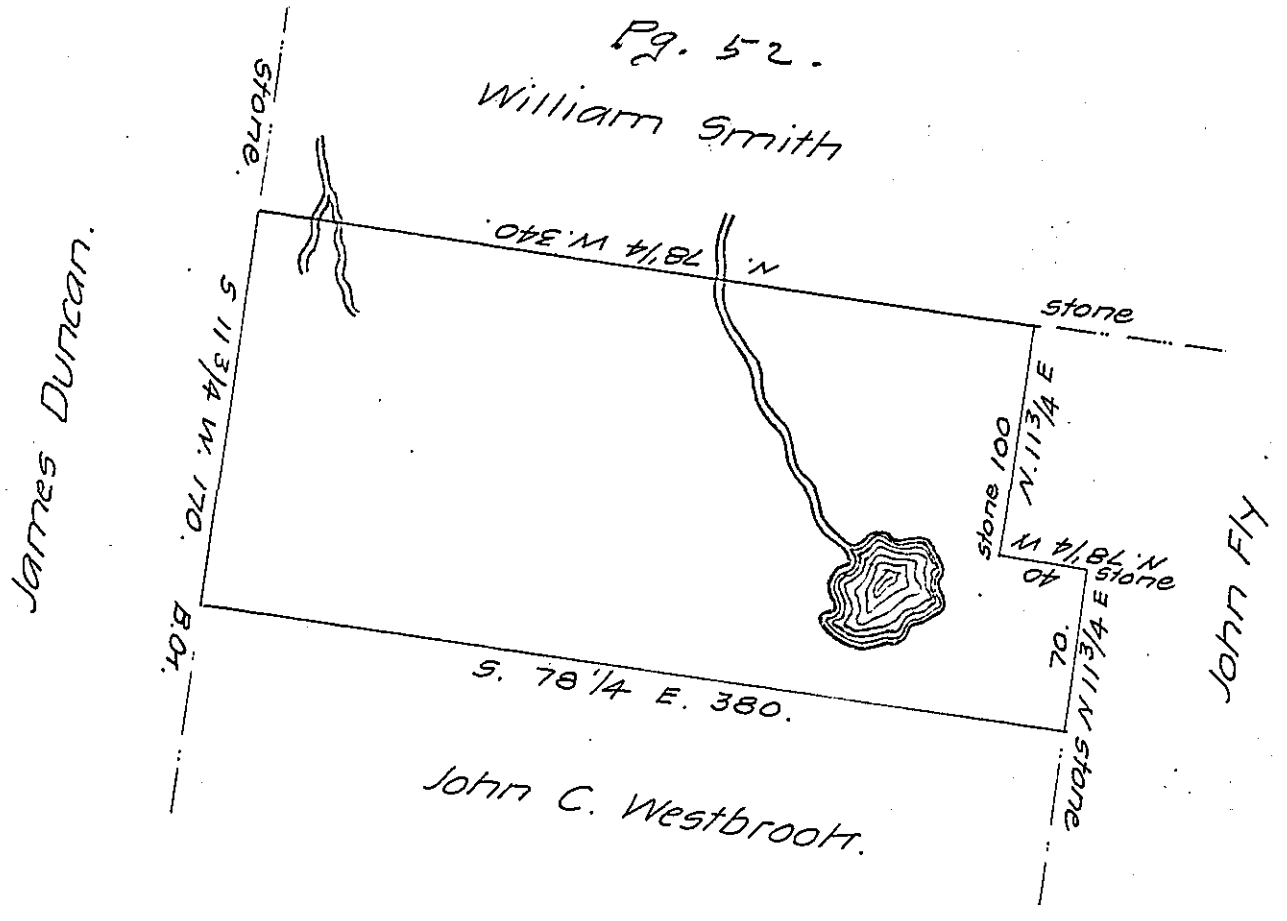


Palmyra

By virtue of a Warrant dated the 2d day of February 1793 and order of survey rec'd the 16th day of November 1850. Surveyed the 5th day of February 1851 to Henry Darrach the above described tract of land situate in Palmyra Township (formerly Northampton) now Pike County, including Stoney Brook on Wallenpaupack containing three hundred and fifty one acres, six perches and the allowance of six pr. Ct. for roads &c.
