


FORM NO. 1.



In pursuance of a law passed the 11th day of April, 1799 for  
the selling certain reserved tracts of land therein named, the in-  
structions of the late Governor dated 14th May 1799 and the or-  
der of the Surveyor General thereupon dated 18th day of May  
1799. Surveyed the 13th day of November 1799, the above  
described tract of land being Lot No. 17 of the reserved tract  
called Franklin in (now) Venango County containing one hun-  
dred and forty two acres and ninety nine perches, strict measure.
