

In Pursuance of an Act of General Assembly of the State of Pennsylvania  
 Passed the 24<sup>th</sup> day of February 1785 entitled "An Act for directing  
 the Mode of distributing the Donation Lands promised the Troops  
 of this "Common Wealth," and by order of the Surveyor General with  
 the Approbation of the Hon<sup>e</sup> the Executive Council I have Survey'd  
 on the 22<sup>nd</sup> day of September 1785 the above described Tract of  
 two hundred acres of Land and Allowance of Six & C<sup>t</sup> for roads &c.  
 N<sup>o</sup> DCCLXIV situate in District N<sup>o</sup> 4 on the West of the Alligany river  
 in the County of Westmoreland.
