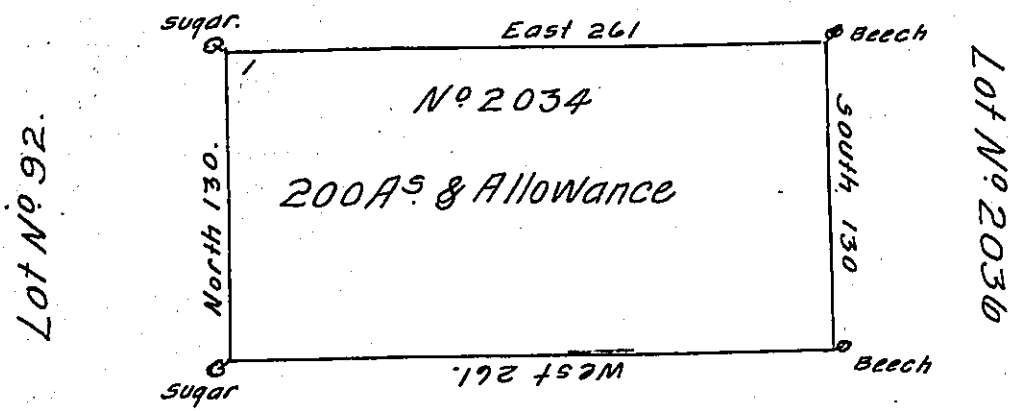

In pursuance of an act of General Assembly of the State of Pennsylvania, passed the 24<sup>th</sup> day of February 1785, entitled "An act for directing the mode of distributing the donation lands promised to the troops of this Commonwealth; And by order of the Surveyor General with the approbation of the Hon<sup>ble</sup> Executive Council, I have surveyed on the 28 day of July 1785 the above described tract of two hundred Acres and Allowance of six  $\frac{7}{8}$  Ct for roads &c. N<sup>o</sup> MMXXXIV, situate in district N<sup>o</sup> 10, on the West side of Alleghany river, in the County of Westmoreland.
