

In Pursuance of an Act of General Assembly of the State of Pennsylvania, passed the 24<sup>th</sup> day of February 1785, entitled an Act for directing the Mode of distributing the Donation Lands promised the Troops of this Commonwealth; And by order of the Surveyor General with the Approbation of the Hon<sup>ble</sup> the Executive Council I have Surveyed on the 3<sup>rd</sup> day of October 1785, The above described Tract of two Hundred Acres of Land & Allowance of Six Pr<sup>c</sup>ent for Roads &c.
