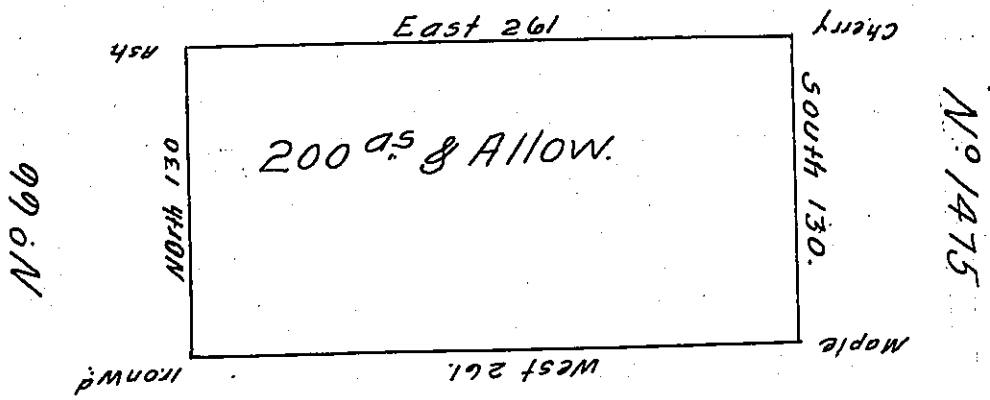

In pursuance of an act of Gen<sup>l</sup> Assembly of the State of Pennsylvania <sup>nia</sup>  
 passed the 24<sup>th</sup> day of February 1785. Intituled an act for Directing the  
 mode of Distributing the Donation Lands promised to the troops  
 of this Commonwealth & by order of the Surveyor Gen<sup>l</sup> With the Ap-  
 probation of the Hon<sup>l</sup> the Executive Council. I have Surveyed on  
 the 3<sup>d</sup> day of Sept<sup>r</sup> 1785. the Above Discribed tract of two Hund-  
 red A<sup>s</sup> & Allow. of 6<sup>th</sup> Cent for Roads &c. N<sup>o</sup> MDX. situate in Dist<sup>ct</sup>  
 N<sup>o</sup> 7. on the west side of the Alleg<sup>y</sup> River in the Co. of Westm<sup>d</sup>
