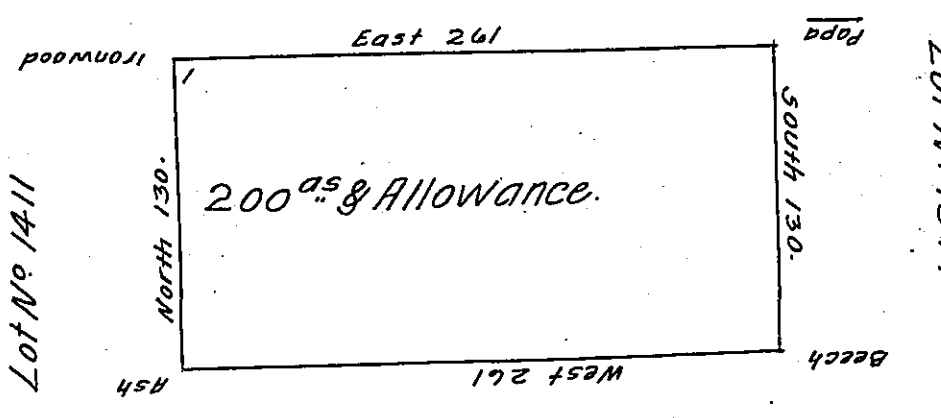

In pursuance of an Act of General Assembly of the state of Pennsylvania, passed the 24<sup>th</sup> day of Febuary 1785. Intituled An act for Directing the mode of Distributing the Donation Lands Promised to the troops Of this Commonwealth & by order of the Surveyor General With the Approbation of the Hon<sup>l</sup> the Executive Council, I have surveyed on the 5<sup>th</sup> day of Aug<sup>t</sup> 1785. the Above Described tract of two Hundred Acres & Allow<sup>ce</sup> of 6<sup>th</sup> Cent for Roads &c. N<sup>o</sup> MCCC LXXXV. - situate in District N<sup>o</sup> 7 on the West side of the Allegeny - in the County of Westmorland.
