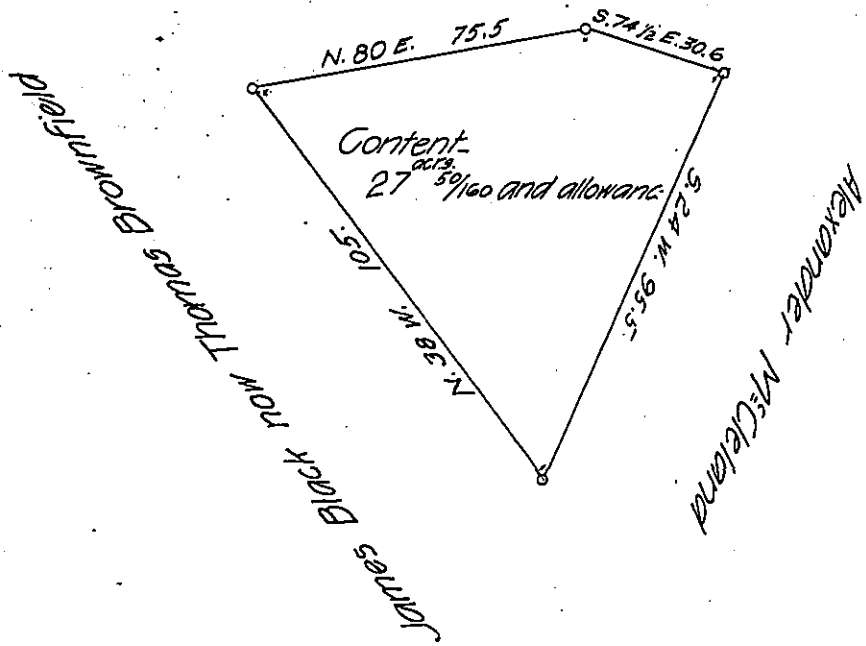


Surveyed April 18<sup>th</sup>, 1837.
