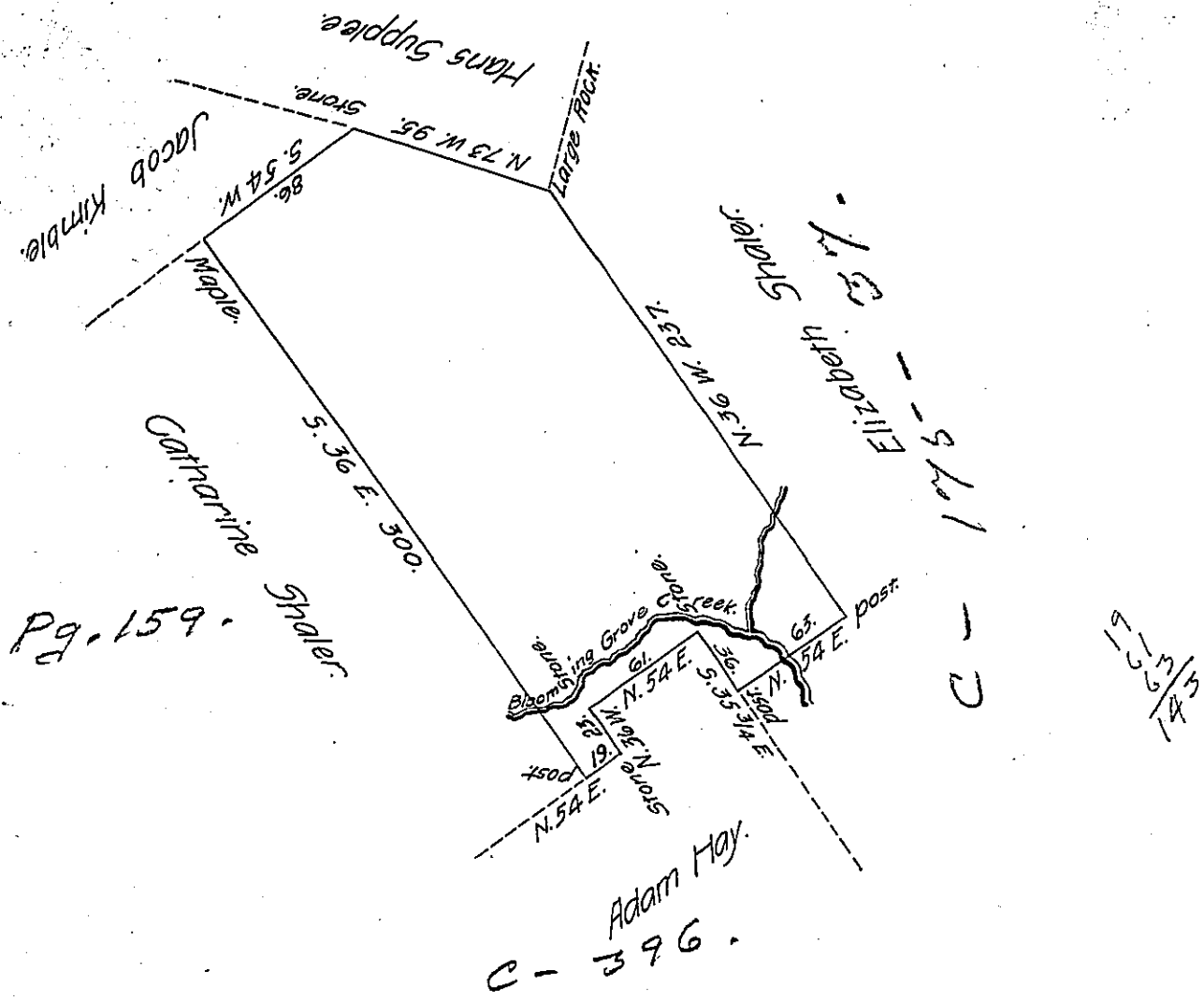


B. Grove -

Surveyed the 27th day of July, 1845, to Rachel Shaler (for William Nyce) the above described Tract of Land situate in Palmyra Township (formerly Northampton) now Pike County adjoining land surveyed to Elizabeth Shaler. Containing two hundred and thirty six acres one hundred and fifty four perches and allowance of six p^e Ct. for Roads &c.
