



Situate in Buffalo Township, Union County, Surveyed the 8th day of July, 1836, by Virtue of an Order granted to David Frame dated the 5th day of November, 1767, N^o 4550. Containing forty nine Acres and one hundred & fifty six perches & the usual allowance &c. & is represented by the Green lines.

Note. The same land interferes & is included in a survey made the 9th day of October, 1773, for John Forster in pursuance of his warrant dated the 18th of August, 1773, & now owned by Robert C. Hall in right of the said John Forster & is represented by the Blue lines.
