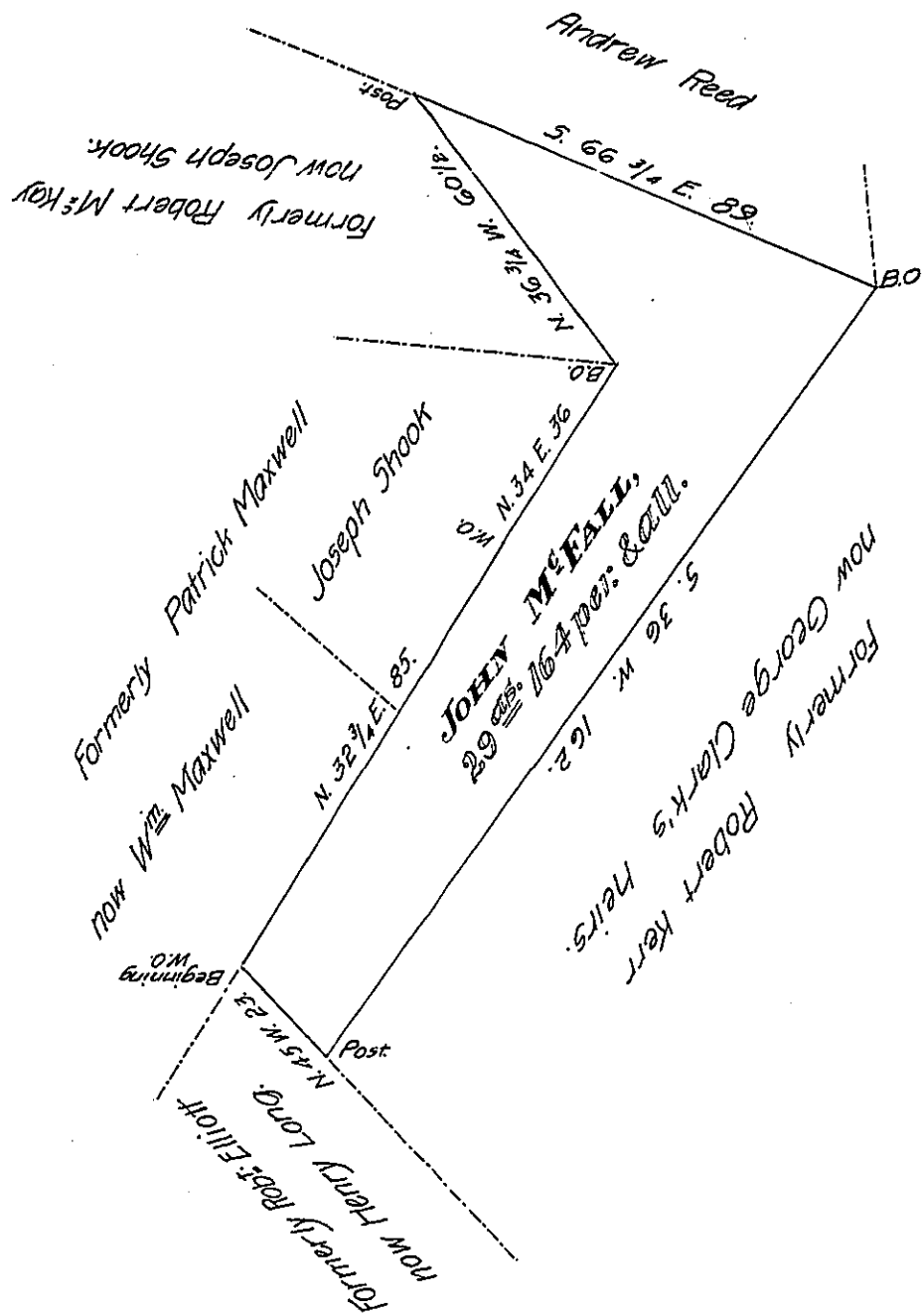


FORM NO 1.



Draft of a Tract land Situate in Montgomery Township (formerly Peters township) Franklin County. Containing Twenty nine acres one hundred & sixty four perches & allowance of six per cent for Roads, &c. Surveyed the 11<sup>th</sup> of April, 1828 (on an Application granted John Mc Fall for 100<sup>acs</sup> of land joining Robert Mc Kay, William Lowry, Widow Davis, Robert Kerr, Robert Elliott & Patrick Maxwell in Peters Township, dated the 16<sup>th</sup> of November, 1767, N<sup>o</sup> 4577). In pursuance of a contract with the Board of Property for carrying into effect the several Acts of Assembly relating to proprietary rights, &c.
