right - & the Tract marked B held on a Warrant to Noah Abraham for 150 Acres dated 8 November, 1787,  
as per Office Draft. Note no evidence of possession in Campbell or of any person ever claiming under this Lo-  
cation, although the Land appears fairly embraced in said location. W<sup>m</sup> S. Davis.

of the Tract A. No Abraham - not Pat<sup>d</sup>.
