



Situate in West Penn Township, Schuylkill County, "(formerly Penns Township, Northampton County)" Containing Sixty one acres, and sixty four perches & allowance of Six per Cent for Roads &c. Being part of the same tract of land originally surveyed by virtue of an application No. 3234, dated the 20 day of April, 1768, by the Honorable the proprietors & granted unto Andrew Foeller for 150 acres, adjoining John Shafer and John Wisimis land over the Blue Hills, on Mahony-, Northampton County, Resurveyed and Returned as the property of Samuel Zimmerman the 14th day of February, 1853.
