



Situate In Allegheny township Huntingdon County Containing Three Hundred and Sixteen acres and one hundred and twenty perches and allowance of Six per Cent for roads & Ca. Surveyed for Jacob Wolven on order N^o 398 dated 1st day of August 1766. The dotted lines represent part of a Survey made for John Holliday on Warrant dated the 21st day of February 1793. This Survey interferes Thirty two and one half Acres with the Jacob Wolven Survey. Jacob Wolven conveyed to Baynton Wharton & Margen from whom the title descended to Michal T. Simpson who conveyed to John Holliday who had obtained the aforesaid warrant and then Conveyed to Thomas Snyder, the present owner.
