The Northern tract included in yellow line above is the same, which was surveyed for 351% A & all unto Michael Bretzius on the 4 April 1785 by Virtue of a Wat^r granted to him dated the 1 November M. Bretzius 1784. — The Southern tract included in the yellow line is the 2 Warts same which was surveyed unto the said Michael Bretzius on the both Part^s 5 April 1785 by a Wat^r granted to him dated the 1 November 1784 for 440 A — The line of Michael Rees tract on the South side appears to have been made in 1763. the improvement is said to have been commenced about 2 years prior to the date of the Warr^t
