



Situate on the North side of Buffaloe Creek in the township of Hartley County of Union. Surveyed the 11<sup>th</sup> day of April 1836 by Virtue of an Order granted to Henry Quigley Senr Dated the 3<sup>d</sup> of April 1769 N<sup>o</sup> 1712 Containing three hundred Acres & one hundred & fifty Perches & the usual Allowance & c and is represented by the Green Lines.

Note: The same Interferes & c is included in two Surveys in the names of Ludwick Karcher & Baltis ClinSmith. Karcher Survey was made the 20<sup>th</sup> May 1776 in pursuance of his warrant Dated 22<sup>d</sup> April 1776 ClinSmith Survey was made 26<sup>th</sup> March 1777 warrant Dated 21<sup>st</sup> Feby. 1776 & c is represented by the Blue lines.
