


James Dale.



Situate in White Deer township Union County Surveyed the 31st day of August 1832 by virtue of an order of Survey granted to Stoffer Lebb dated the 3^d day of April 1769 N^o. 2251. Containing three hundred and twenty acres with the usual Allowance of six & cent. 8c^e.

Note: The same tract of land was surveyed the 2^d day of June 1794 for William Armstrong by virtue of his order dated the 3^d day of April 1769 N^o. — And now owned and occupied by James Sanderson in right of the said William Armstrong
