

Situate in West Buffaloe township Union (late Berks) county Surveyed the II # day of October 1833 By Virtue of an order of Survey Granted to George Mengics dated the 3d day of April 1769 Nº 1762 Containing three Hundred and eleven Acres & Seventy five perches and the usual Allowance 8cc.

Note the same tract of land was surveyed for John Berreyman the 7th day of August 1769 in pursuance of his Order Dated 3d day of April 1769 & Number 101 and now owned by Michael Roush in right of the said John Perreyman
