


Samuel Geddys Land

Located in pursuance of an Order of Survey dated the 8th of April 1767 No 3378 Granted to Robert Magaw for one hundred acres "joining Thomas Daugherty John Barnett James Patterson William McCamish & Samuel Geddys in Hamilton Township" And by virtue of a contract with the Board of Property for ascertaining Surveying & returning unpatented Lands under proprietary rights &c &c.
