



Situate in Chapman township Union County Surveyed the 5th day of June 1834 in pursuance of an Order granted to Philip Erb dated the 7th day of April 1767 No. 3355 Containing One hundred and five Acres and forty eight perches with the usual allowance of Six per Cent &c.

Note The same tract of land was surveyed the 16th day of October 1765 for William Blyth by virtue of his order dated the 10th July 1762 No — Now owned & possessed by Frederic Herrold & the Heirs of Simon Herrold in right of the said
