

Acres & twenty eight perches and allowance of six per cent for Roads &c  
Surveyed for John Zimmerman on Order No 3198 dated the 25<sup>th</sup> day of  
March 1767

No. 1. Represented by the dotted lines is a draft of a tract of land  
Surveyed for John Houser on Warrant dated the 7<sup>th</sup> day of March 1785 - This  
tract interferes Sixty two acres and twenty eight perches with the John Zimmerman  
Survey - John Zimmerman conveyed to Lemmon Jackson who had bought  
part of the aforesaid Warrant and had the same executed - the same was  
sold by the Sheriff of Bedford County from said Lemmon Jackson to  
John Graves the present Owner
