

The Lake coulered lines represent part of the draught of a tract of Land surveyed for Abednigo Stevens on Warrant dated the 23rd day of November 1785. This tract interferes one hundred and twenty six acres and one hundred and twenty seven perches - with the Benjin Stevens Survy - Benjin Stevens conveyed to Abednigo Stevens who obtained the aforesaid Warrant and conveyed to Abraham Tanner, who devised the same to Jacob Tanner the present owner.
