In pursuance of the several Acts of Assembly directing the recovery of the principal and interest due to the Commonwealth from Persons holding Lands by Virtue of Locations or other Office Titles issued from or under the Proprietary Government and for other purposes, I have this day located and surveyed Application 3114 - granted 19<sup>th</sup> March 1767 to Benjamin Ried for 100 acres in Hamiltonban<sup>n</sup> Township on lands situate in Hamiltonban<sup>n</sup> Township aforesaid, and have found the Interferences as represented in the enclosed diagram.
