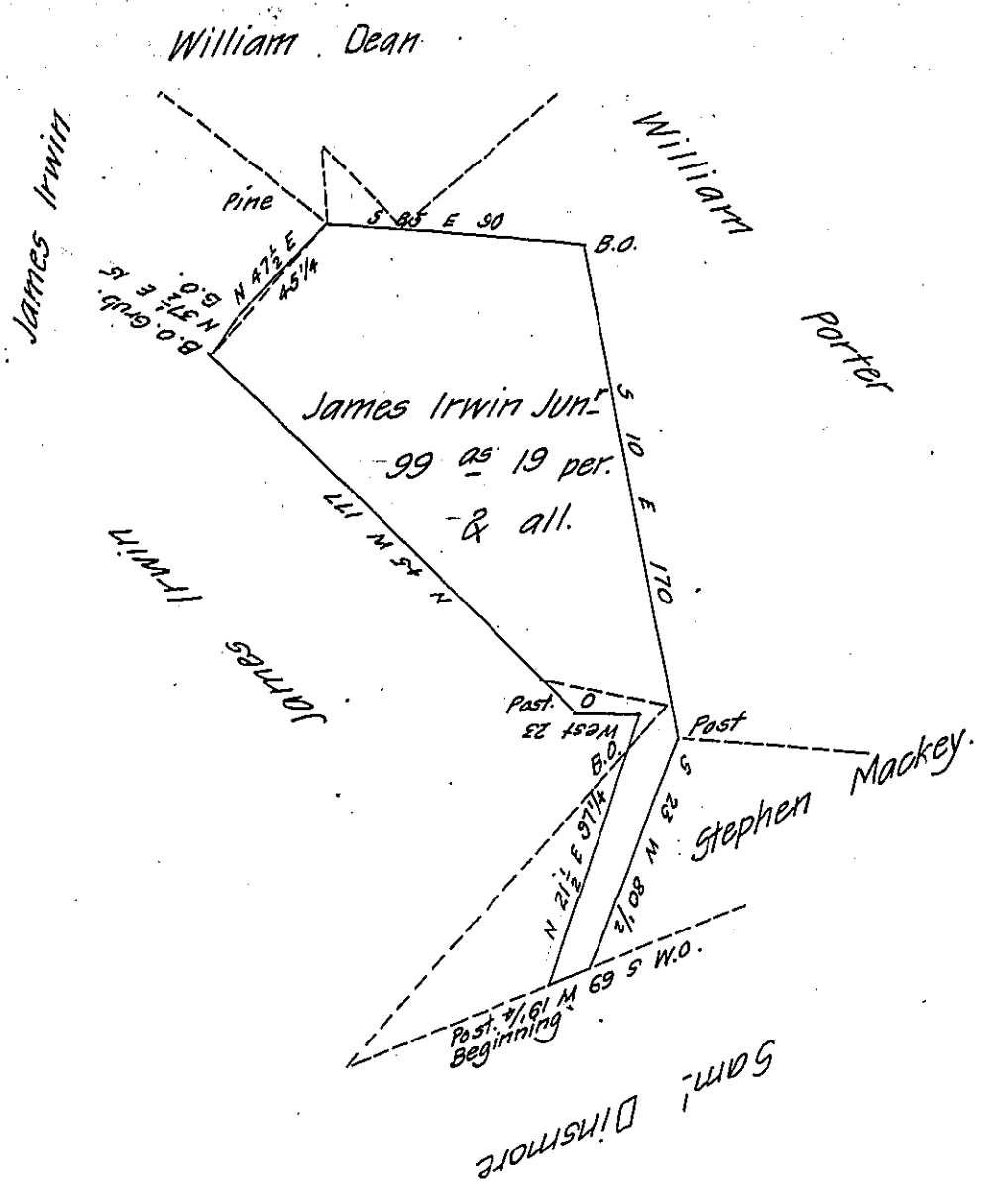

 &c which was surveyed the 29th of March 1769 on an Application granted James
 Irwin Junr for 200^{acs} of land including his improvement joining James Irwin
 Senr Wm Dean John Cummings Stephen Mackey & Samuel Dinsmore in Peters
 township dated the 26th of May 1767 No 3731 Certified the 16th of Feb^y 1829 in
 pursuance of a Contract with the Board of Property for carrying into effect the
 several acts of Assembly relating to Proprietary Rights &c.
