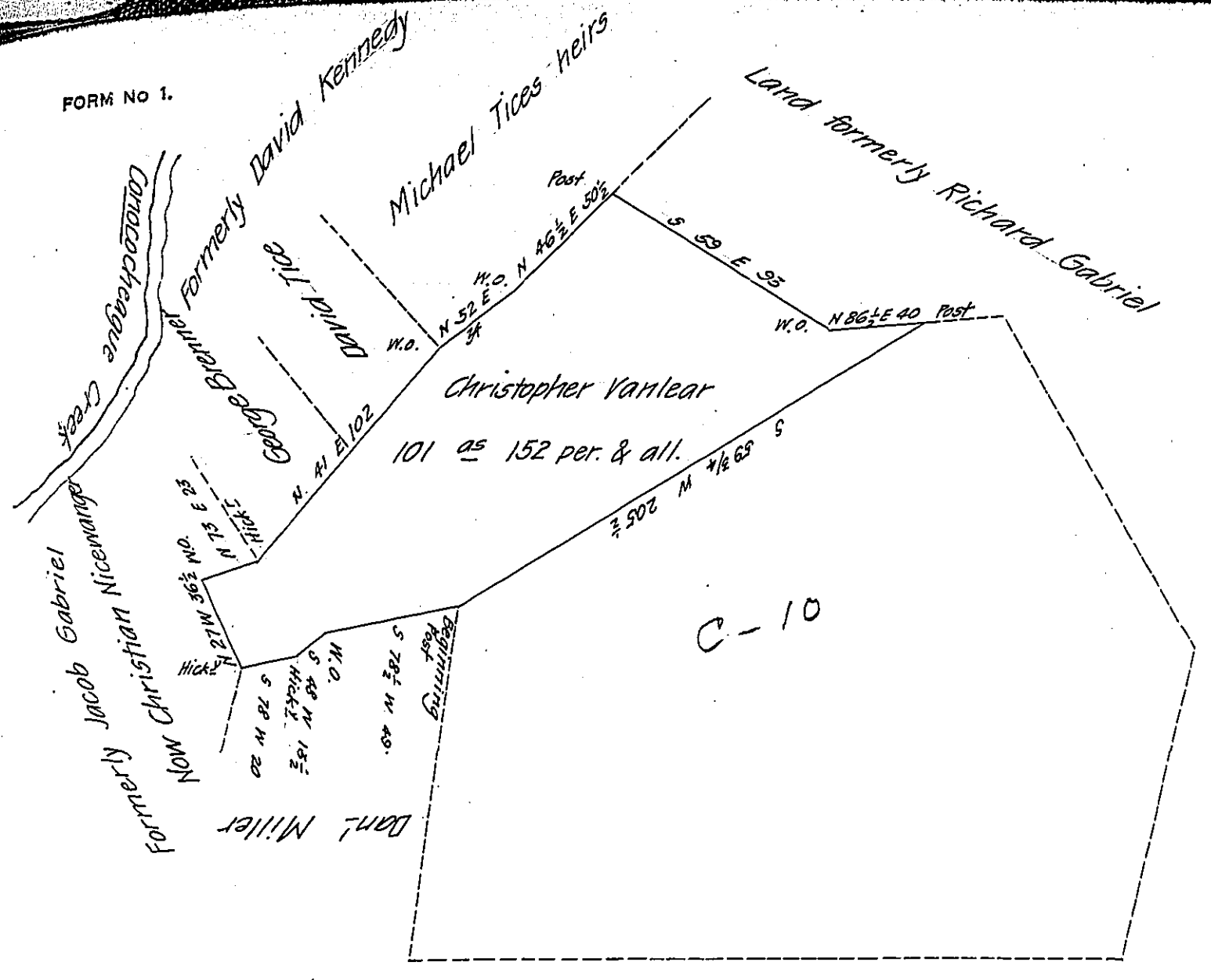

Draft of a tract of land situate in Antrim township Franklin County containing One Hundred & one acres One hundred & fifty two perches & allowance of six per Cent for roads &c Surveyed the 25<sup>th</sup> of December 1829 (on an Application granted Christopher Vanlear for 100<sup>ac</sup> of land in Antrim township Bounded by Jacob Gabriel David Kennedy & S.E. of Conococheague Creek dated the 26<sup>th</sup> of May 1767 No. 3730) in pursuance of a Contract with the Board of Property for carrying into effect the several Acts of Assembly relating to Proprietary rights &c.

The land above described is included in a larger Survey containing 394<sup>ac</sup> & all which was surveyed in pursuance of 2 warrants granted William Cross dated the 18<sup>th</sup> of October 1753 & the 25<sup>th</sup> of May 1768 the land is now held by virtue of the Survey made on Cross's 2 Warrants. No evidence of any survey having been made on the application of Christopher Van Lear.
