

for Jacob Taylor the 26th day of July 1786 on Warrant dated the 13th day
of September 1785 - this Survey interfers one hundred & twelve Acres &
thirty-five perches with the Andrew Steel tract Andrew Steel conveyed to
Jacob Taylor who obtained the above recited Warrant & conveyed to Adam
Shurich from whom the same was sold by the Sheriff of Bedford County
to John Heltzell the present owner.
