



Draft of a tract of land situate in Montgomery township (formerly Peters township) Franklin County containing two hundred & fifteen acres five perches & allowance of six per cent for roads &c. Surveyed the 11th of December 1828 in pursuance of a Contract with the Board of Property for carrying into effect the several Acts of Assembly relating to Proprietary Rights & on an Application granted James Mc Fee for 200^{ac} of land joining James Rankin & the two top Mountain in Peters township dated the 27th of April 1767 No 3529

The land above described is claimed now by the following rights viz:
 the part marked A is the same as a survey containing 112^{ac} 32 per. & all. which was surveyed on an Application granted James Rankin dated the 3^d of March 1769 No 5351. The part marked B. Containing 102^{ac} 133 per. & all. is included in a survey containing 103^{ac} 91 per. & all. which was surveyed on a Warrant granted James Rankin dated the 9th of January 1794. James Mc Fee sold the above land to James Rankin who took out the above rights.
