



A draft of a tract of land situate on the Waters of Dunning's Creek about 6½ miles North from Bedford - In the Township and County of Bedford - containing One hundred & ninety five acres and one hundred & thirty two perches and allowance of Six per Cent for roads &c. Surveyed for George Sell on Order No 2730 dated the 6<sup>th</sup> day of February 1767.

NB. The Green lines represent a survey of a tract of land surveyed for George Sell in pursuance of a Warrant dated the 16<sup>th</sup> day of December 1784 - this survey Interferes one hundred and ninety five acres & one hundred & thirty two perches with the George Sell tract - George Sell obtained the above order of Survey and also the above recited Warrant for the same tract. He devised it to Abraham Sell & Daniel Sell the present owners.
