The purple lines represent the draught of a tract of land surveyed for Nicholas Roof on warrant dated the 22<sup>nd</sup> day of November 1787. This tract interferes two hundred and eighty one Acres with the Michael Huff survey - Michael Huff conveyed to William Fredrigal who conveyed to Nicholas Koortz who conveyed to Gideon Ritchey who conveyed to Nicholas Roof who obtained the aforesaid warrant and conveyed to John May Esqr. who devised the same to John May the present owner - The dotted lines represent part of the draught of a tract of Land surveyed for Francis Campbell on Warrant dated the 5<sup>th</sup> day of June 1762. This tract interferes ninety eight acres and thirty seven perches with the Michael Huff Survey. Francis Campbell conveyed to George Morgan John Baynton and Samuel Wharton who conveyed to Richard Neave Sen<sup>r</sup> & Son - who conveyed to Robert McKnight whose heirs appear to have abandoned their claim to said Land.
