



Situate in White Deer township Union (late Berks) County Surveyed the 18<sup>th</sup> day of September 1832 by virtue of an Order granted to Jacob Blessing dated the 3<sup>d</sup> day day of April 1769 N<sup>o</sup> 1695 Containing three hundred and Nineteen Acres with the usual Allowance of Six pr. Cent. &c.

Note: The above mentioned tract of land was surveyed the 23<sup>d</sup> day of October 1769 for William M<sup>c</sup>Corkle in pursuance of his order dated the 3<sup>d</sup> day of April 1769 N<sup>o</sup> 1539 And now owned and Occupied by David Lennox in right of the said William M<sup>c</sup>Corkle
