



SITUATE in Buffalo township Union (late Berks) County Surveyed the 8th. day of May 1833 by virtue of an Order granted to Marion Lemar dated the 3^d. day of April 1769 No. 1125 Containing One hundred & sixty three acres with the usual allowance of six & 2/5 Cent. &c.

Note - The same tract of land was surveyed the 4th. day of October 1769 for Andrew Culbertson in pursuance of his Order dated the 3^d. day of April 1769 No. 296. And now owned and occupied by John Cowdon in right of the said Andrew Culbertson.
