

Situate in Hartley township Union County Surveyed the 24th day of March 1836 by Virtue of an Order dated the 3 day of April 1769. Nº 2288 Granted to Henry Meyer Containing three Hundred & thirty one Acres & one hundred & fifty Seven perches with the Usual Allowance &C. Note. The Same tract of land was surveyed the 25th day of September 1772 for Thomas Hartley Esqr. in pursuance of his Warrant dated the 11th day of September 1772 And 15 now owned & occupied by Henry Miller & others in right of the Said Thomas Hartley Pr Jnº Hayes Cont To John Taylor Esgr. Surveyor General Penn.
